

Performance Awards & Happy Hacking Information 2019

These awards are aimed at every member who has a Fell pony and whether you are competing regularly at events or are just enjoying a good hack, please take part in the Happy Hacking or Performance/ Activity Awards sections or both. There is no charge!

- Entries must be with Alyson no later than 20th October 2019 **however if you are competing on the 20th October** you have seven days to get your form(s) to Alyson. This is to allow for checking, collation of points and to submit an order for rosettes. You can also send your completed form by e-mail to Alyson at alysonhurcomb@gmail.com PLEASE MAKE A COPY OF YOUR FORM(S) AND CHECK SHE HAS RECEIVED THEM.
- Please provide your pony's full registered name and mark where required if a veteran (15 years plus).
- On Line competition results will not be included.
- Every pony must have a separate entry sheet e.g. if you are entering two ponies, you must fill a form in for each one. If you are entering both ponies in the performance and happy hacking sections you will therefore require four forms.
- Entry forms should be linked to the pony and not the rider(s). This is especially important in the Happy Hacking section where the forms should be linked to the pony and not the rider(s). We realize that some families do share a pony but the award will go to the pony.
- When entering performance awards information please describe the class entered or event e.g. if you were placed at Staffs County Show please enter what class it was such as Large Breeds In Hand Mountain and Moorland. This will help Alyson check show results more readily.
- You can back date your entries and signatures from show officials. Please round up your Happy Hacker time to the nearest 1/4 of an hour.
- The Activity and Performance Awards section is not just for ponies that are shown. Activity could mean a instance where your Fell has stood on a breed stand or represented the breed at an event, taken part in a charitable event, competed in TREC, dressage or a sponsored ride, competed in a gymkhana or assisted the RDA, the list goes on! If you are not sure of the points you have accrued just post your entry off to Alyson who will sort them out for you.
- You must be a fully paid up member of the Midlands West FPSS Group to enter. You can send a subscription to Barry Stamp at the time of entering.

There will be a separate event to present awards. Venue date and time to be arranged but will probably take place in December 2019.
